

B-DAQ Tutorial

The B-DAQ Tutorial is a HTML based help system used mainly for training purposes. A copy of the Tutorial is available to train new operators, and can be made available to the operator in the bindery for help with various procedures. The tutorial opens in Internet Explorer via the Help button on the B-DAQ Mainscreen, and can also be made available to any other user via a desktop shortcut.

Install

- ◆ Create a new directory on the B-DAQ Server: C:\PDAQ\B-Tutorial.
- ◆ Download B-Tutorial.zip from our website (www.nastechinc.com/SoftwareRelease/B-Tutorial.zip)
- ◆ Extract the files to the new directory preserving the directory structure.
- ◆ When extracted, there should be a BDAQ-Tutorial.htm, and a B-TutorialData directory in the new directory.
- ◆ In the **C:\BDAQ\B-###** directories, edit the Bindery.ini file for each machine to include the following line of code in the **Constants** section:
- ◆ Help Link = "C:\Program Files\Internet Explorer\explore.exe
\\YourBdaqServer\BDAQ\B-Tutorial\BDAQ-Tutorial.htm"

Run the Tutorial in the Bindery:

- ◆ To run the Tutorial, each Bindery computer must have permission to run Internet Explorer, and permission to open the files from the server.
- ◆ Once the Bindery.ini file has been updated at each machine, click the **Help** button on the B-DAQ Mainscreen to open.

Run the Tutorial from the Client:

- ◆ To run the Tutorial, each client computer must have permission to run Internet Explorer, and permission to open the files from the server.
- ◆ Create a shortcut on the desktop to:
